- o Participate in the Girl Scout Cookie Sale with at least a 10% increase over last year's troop sales, and the troop must have reports submitted on time with no outstanding debts. If a new troop, your troop should have 100% participation by members, and the troop must have reports submitted on time with no outstanding debts.
- o Submit all completed end of the year troop paperwork and required materials (i.e. copies of bank statements) to your Membership Manager by the June 15th deadline.
