



Say hello to 42 NEW Girl Scout badges and one NEW Journey exclusively for girls!

Excited?! The new programming allows girls to make their own choices about how they want to experience and influence the world while preparing them to address some of society's most pressing needs through hands-on learning and real-life problem-solving in cybersecurity, coding, space exploration, and citizen science. But wait, there's more! For the first time ever, girls can choose between two ways of earning their Outdoor badges—it's an adventure seeker's dream come true!

Giving girls choices is important for developing their sense of self, their own voice, and gender equality: research from the World Bank Group shows that increasing women's agency and decision-making abilities is key to improving their lives, communities, and the world. Additionally, Girl Scouts are more likely than other girls to take an active role in decision making (80% vs. 51%).

You're invited to the blaze-your-own-trail adventure. We hope you love it as much as we do!

The new programming for girls in grades K–12 includes:

- **12 Outdoor High Adventure badges**, designed for girls to explore nature and experience exciting outdoor adventures like backpacking, snowshoeing, cross-country skiing, rock climbing, and tree climbing—giving them the confidence to support one another, take healthy risks, and spend dedicated time in nature.
- **18 Coding for Good badges**, which not only teach girls the basics of coding but also detail how every stage of the coding process provides girls with opportunities to use their skills for good.

The new programming for girls in grades 6–12 includes:

- **Nine Cybersecurity badges**, created in partnership with Palo Alto Networks, through which girls learn about the inner workings of computer technology and cybersecurity.
- **Three Space Science badges**, through which girls explore topics such as the universe and their place in it, properties of light, and inspiring careers in space science (funded by NASA's Science Mission Directorate and led by the SETI Institute).
- **Think Like a Citizen Scientist, a Girl Scout Leadership Journey** during which girls participate in interactive activities to practice observation techniques; collect data; and share their findings with real-world scientists through an online network.

The new badges are available at your local Girl Scout Shop. And badge requirements can be found on the Volunteer Toolkit and Badge Explorer. Badge inserts will arrive in your local Girl Scout Shop in August.

2020 GIRL SCOUT COOKIE PRICE INCREASE

UPCOMING PRICE INCREASE GIVES MORE PROCEEDS TO TROOPS

Girl Scouts Heart of the South is growing and thriving, which is great news, and your role is vital to our program's success.

As we are faced with increasing costs to deliver our unique leadership development program to our girls, we must continue to find ways to deliver the best possible Girl Scout Leadership Experience to members.

As many of you are aware, our cookie prices have not increased since 2015. However, just as our daily living costs increase, our costs for goods has gone up as well over the past 5 years. This year, Girl Scouts Heart of the South will join 76% of councils with cookie prices at \$5 for core cookies and \$6 for specialty cookies (S'mores, Toffee-tastic) this upcoming season. This price increase is based on high production costs from the bakery, requests for troop profits, and increased expenses to provide outstanding girl programming.

We are giving you advance notice so that you can prepare for the upcoming Cookie season.

What does this mean for troops?

With the price increase, girls and their troops will be able to earn more funds to power their Girl Scout experience via a tiered proceed plan.

In addition, we are launching the Super Troop Program where troops can earn an additional \$.05 per box making the total amount potentially earned \$.85 per box – an increase of \$.22 over the previous troop maximum proceed schedule.

What does this mean for service units?

Service Unit proceeds will remain the same for the 2020 Girl Scout Cookie Program. In 2021, we will introduce Super Service Unit which will offer service units the opportunity to raise more money to support the Girl Scout Leadership Experience in their communities.

NEW NUMBER OPTION FOR MULTI-LEVEL TROOPS

MULTI-LEVEL AND SISTER TROOPS CAN NOW HAVE SAME TROOP NUMBER

We've got an exciting change to share with you about changes to our troop numbering process. As we create new troops and assign numbers to volunteers in our membership database, any new troops that will operate as what have traditionally been "multi-level" or "sister" troops will have more consistent numbering.

This innovative take on troop numbering will provide a solution to the difficulties that often arise with multi-level troops and that will create a best practice on troop numbers so that girl members, volunteers and staff have an easier time identifying, remembering and communicating about their troops.

Moving forward, any troop co-leaders that will be working with multiple troops will be assigned a single five digit number for their troops and a letter will be added to the end to signify the grade level of each troop. What exactly might this look like? Here is an example. A new volunteer that we'll call Juliette Acevedo wants to start troops for her Kindergartener and her 5th grader. In getting her troops established, we would assign her troop number 12345 and her Kindergarten troop would be Troop 12345D (where the D is for Daisy) and her 5th grader would be in Troop 12345J (where J is for Junior).

In this example, the girls and volunteers would share the same troop numbers for their uniforms and could engage their communities as one large troop. Ms. Acevedo, with her other troop co-leaders (even if they were different at each program grade level) could decide whether or not she

wanted one bank account to share for both or one for each troop. (We recommend one for each troop.) Additionally, if you currently have a single troop number, but will be adding a second troop in the future, we will apply this process as our standard operating procedure.

For any existing troops that are operating with multiple grade levels under a single troop number, we will begin evaluating this option and making this switch where necessary over the course of the year, working with volunteers to improve troop operations.

For any existing troops where a single volunteer is working with multiple troops that wants to make this change, we are prepared to do so at your request. Some of you have consecutive troop numbers now, some have the same five troop numbers flipped around in multiple ways and some have a random selection of five numbers. Thankfully, making this troop numbering change is a quick, simple process in our systems.

Please be sure to speak with your girls about these options, as older girl troops who might have had the same number for a long time might not find this to be ideal. If you would like to discuss your options or are ready to move forward with this change, please contact our customer care team.

As far as we can tell, we will be the first council in the country to move forward with this troop numbering process, but as we've talked with our vendors and other councils to share the idea, it is generating a positive buzz.

We're excited to announce the return of Super Troops to Girl Scouts Heart of the South!

Even better than that, Super Troops will be incentivized in some awesome ways, including recognition in council publications, a special patch for all girls in the troop, and an additional cookie proceed to be paid out next summer.

Super Troop REQUIREMENTS FOR 2019-2020

BE A STRONG AND SUSTAINABLE TROOP

- Have room for at least 12 girls in your troop and keep your troop visible to prospective members for registration in the Opportunity Catalog.
- Review troop Opportunity Catalog listing and update troop information, including adding a unique troop description by September 30, 2019.
- Elevate the importance of the Girl Scout uniform with all girls having required uniform elements, and wearing them while participating in public activities.

BE A SISTER TO EVERY GIRL SCOUT

- Have at least 65% of girl and adult members renewed by September 30, 2019.
- For Girl Scout Ambassador troops with graduating seniors, 65% of eligible girls must be renewed as adults by September 30, 2019.

LEAD GIRLS

- Have two troop co-leaders, and the required girl: adult ratios, registered with current and by September 30, 2019.
- Complete most recent versions of Volunteer Opportunity Checkpoints, completing the Volunteer Toolkit by October 1, 2019.

FINANCE REPORT AND BANK STATEMENTS

IMPORTANT CHANGES TO TIME LINE

Due to the difficulties expressed by many troop volunteers around the September submission deadline, we are changing the time line for completing troop finance reports.

You'll still find the Troop Finance Report in the VTK, conveniently located for you to access, upload and share. Some minor items have been updated on the report which should help address some additional concerns shared after our first year utilizing this new functionality.

Among these updates are a space to indicate if your finance report is for more than one troop and a more emphasized request to upload your bank statements.

Here's what you need to know for this submission:

The reporting period has been revised to cover all income and expenses of the troop(s) from September 1, 2018 through May, 31, 2019.

The submission period has been revised. Troop Finance Reports, and the accompanying bank statements, should now be submitted to the council between June 1 and July 31, 2019.

The bank statements that will be required this year are: September 2018, December 2018 and March 2019.

As a reminder, troops are only allowed one submission through the VTK per membership year, so do not submit before you are ready.

Also be advised that troop co-leaders experienced trouble around the site timing out. To avoid loss of data, be sure you are frequently saving your progress.

On July 1, any troop co-leaders that have not renewed their membership for 2020 and/or do not have a current background check that has an expiration date after September 30, 2019 will lose access to the VTK and, therefore, the ability to submit their finance report and bank statements until those items have been corrected.

This work will continue throughout the summer. Council staff may be contacting service unit team and troop co-leaders about the following specific items:

- Troops that have meeting locations outside of a service unit's zip code listing.
- Troop co-leaders that have multiple troops and "random" troop numbers for those troops.
- Multi-level troops that are not broken out by program grade level.

In these conversations we want to offer opportunities that simplify troop numbers for multi-level troops while considering the specific needs of troops and our members.

DISBANDING TROOPS

WHAT TO DO IF YOU'RE DISBANDING

A disbanded troop is a troop that is no longer meeting, or one that has not registered for at least two months from the membership expiration date (September 30, annually).


Any troop facing disbandment due to the loss of leadership should first attempt to recruit new troop co-leaders for the upcoming year. This helps to ensure continuity of the Girl Scout experience for the girls.

If the troop as a whole has decided not to return for the 2019-2020 membership year, the leadership team should follow the appropriate steps outlined in the council's [Disbanded Troop Process](#) to notify council staff as soon as possible.

Girl Scouts Heart of the South Disbanded Troop Policy states that funds and equipment of disbanded troops are the property of the council and will be returned to the keeping of the council. If reorganization of the troop does not take place within 12 months, the resources will be used by the council in the interest of Girl Scouting.

Thousands of girls and their supporters will come together from around the world October 23-25, 2020, at G.I.R.L. 2020 in Orlando, Florida.



This short, fun and engaging program is a great way for girls to learn important life skills and to earn money for their Girl Scout activities early in the troop year.






