

Volunteer Toolkit 2018-19 Pre-selected Tracks for Your Troop

For the 2018-19 troop year, you have **10 pre-selected track options** to choose from in the Volunteer Toolkit. A year plan can be set up as a Petals/Leaves/Badge Year, a Journey Year or Select Your Own Badges and Awards. You can add, change or delete meetings at any time. **Leader Tip:** Use the information and pictures below to talk with your troop members about which options they'd like to take on this year.

BADGE TRACKS

Daisy Petals, Leaves and Badges

In this Daisy year plan, girls will earn 10 petals, 2 leaves and a Take Action award in 15 meetings. They'll learn how to keep the Girl Scout Promise by living the Girl Scout Law, and earn the petals to make the Daisy Flower. Girls complete a Take Action project.

EARN: Daisy Petals • Money Counts • Count It Up • Take Action Award



Daisy Badge Year 1 NEW

In this Daisy Badge Year, girls will earn 5 badges and 2 leaves in 15 meetings. Girls begin learning what it means to be a citizen by earning the Good Neighbor badge. Then they'll find inspiration in nature to create outdoor art and explore STEM through a variety of Design Challenges. They'll also earn a Financial Literacy and Cookie Business leaf.

EARN: Good Neighbor • Outdoor Art Maker • Board Game Design Challenge • Model Car Design • Roller Coaster Design Challenge • Making Choices • Talk It Up



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Daisy Badge Year 2 NEW

In this Daisy Badge Year, girls will earn 5 badges and 2 leaves in 15 meetings. Girls find new ways to care for the environment as they earn the Eco Learner badge. Then they'll sharpen their STEM skills as they learn about space science and cybersecurity. They'll also earn a Financial Literacy and Cookie Business leaf.

EARN: Eco Friend • Space Science Adventurer • three Cybersecurity badges • Making Choices • Talk It Up



JOURNEY TRACKS

Advocacy: Welcome to the Daisy Flower Garden

On this Journey, girls will earn 3 awards in 9 meetings. Daisies learn about the Girl Scout Promise and Law while planting a mini garden. They use their new skills to help others or to improve their communities.

EARN: Watering Can · Golden Honey Bee · Amazing Daisy Award



Creative Expression: 5 Flowers, 4 Stories, 3 Cheers for Animals

On this Journey, girls will earn 3 awards in 13 meetings. Daisies learn what animals need and how to care for them—and how that is similar to taking care of themselves.

EARN: Bird Bath • Red Robin • Tula Award





Environment: Between Earth and Sky

On this Journey, girls earn 3 awards in 13 meetings. Daisies travel the country living the values of the Girl Scout Law; the flowers explore the natural world around them, learning what's local and why that's important. They experience what's great about their own region and learn to use their own special skills to help people and Planet Earth.

EARN: Blue Bucket • Firefly • Clover Award



Outdoor

On this Journey, Daisies earn 2 badges and a Take Action award in 10 meetings. Daisies will learn all about the outdoors—while creating colorful outdoor art and going on a troop camping trip.

EARN: Outdoor Art Maker • Buddy Camper • Take Action Outdoor Award



STEM Outdoor: Think Like a Citizen Scientist

On this Journey, Daisies earn 2 awards in 9 meetings. Girls practice the scientific method by doing a citizen science project focused on the outdoors. Girls also complete a Take Action project.

STEM: Think Like an Engineer

On this Journey, Daisies earn 2 awards in 9 meetings. Girls learn how to think like an engineer by participating in hands-on design challenges. Girls also complete a Take Action project.

STEM: Think Like a Programmer

On this Journey, Daisies earn 2 awards in 9 meetings. Girls learn how programmers solve problems through fun activities and games. Girls also complete a Take Action project.
