Troop & SU Finance Reports



Every year, troops and service units are asked to submit a finance report to the council. *This is a requirement*.

Finance reports are necessary to ensure the proper management of Girl Scout funds. They protect both the hard-earned funds and the volunteers who manage those accounts. Participation in the Fall Product and Girl Scout Cookie Programs, as well as approval for any additional money-earning activities, may be affected for troops who have not submitted this report. These reports are due between June 1 and July 31, 2025.

Troop Finance Reports

The Troop Finance Report can be found in the Volunteer Toolkit (VTK).

Troop leaders should work with their troop treasurer to complete the report. This year, both troop leaders and troop treasurers have the ability to access and submit the form. Please be sure you work together to determine who will submit the report and ensure the accuracy of the

information submitted.

Here's what you need to know:

- 1. The reporting period is June 1, 2024 through May 31, 2025. Unless a troop has completed all activities for this current year or is disbanding, reports should not be submitted before June 1 to ensure all income and expenses for the reporting period are included.
- 2. The bank statements that will be required this year are: August 2024, October 2024, January 2025, and March 2025. A troop's finance report is not complete without all four of these bank statements.
- 3. Troops are only allowed one submission through the VTK per membership year, so do not submit before you are ready. Once the form has been submitted, it cannot be altered.
- 4. You will have the opportunity to add attachments to your finance report after you have hit the button to submit your report.
- 5. After the report has been submitted, troops should download a copy of their finance report to keep for their records and to forward it to the service unit's finance coordinator.

<u>GSUSA Volunteer Toolkit- Troop Finance View</u>, is available in gsLearn. With this short step-by-step guide, you'll learn more about how you can submit the troop finance report through the VTK. Log in to MyGS, open gsLearn from the left-side menu, and click the <u>link</u> to take a look today!

Service Unit Finance Reports

Each service unit is required to submit a **finance report** no later than July 31, 2025. The report should cover all income and expenses from June 1, 2024 through May 31, 2025. To ensure the full reporting period is included, the form will not accept submissions prior to June 1, 2025. Service units should be prepared to upload bank statements for the following months when submitting their finance report: August 2024, October 2024, January 2025, and March 2025. Service Unit Operation Managers should complete and submit the report.

Service Team Budgets

Budgeting is an important part of the service unit planning and finance management process. Service units are required to submit a budget at the beginning of each program year. As a reminder, service unit proceeds cannot be distributed until service units have both a <u>current budget</u> and a complete <u>finance report</u> on file with the council.

This year, the budget submission period is June 15, 2025 through August 31, 2025. The budget should be developed by the service unit's leadership team to support the program plans for the upcoming year, and submitted HERE by either the Service Unit Operations Manager or Service Unit Finance Coordinator. Once submitted, the volunteer submitting the form will receive an email confirmation of their submission. Please review the Super Troop Requirements for those working on this accomplishment for MY25. Let us know your troop qualifies for this higher achievement by submitting your application online.

The deadline to complete the MY25 requirements for Super Troop status is August 1st each year.

August 2025 Volunteer Spotlight Helen York SU 424 Madison/South Gibson

Helen York's Girl Scout journey began in Jacksonville, Florida, where she was first a Bluebird and then transitioned into Brownies, Juniors, and Cadette Girl Scouts. "We did plays, learned to knit—even in Florida—and made scarves for girls in Maine," she said. "Girl Scouting has been the thread throughout my life."

Helen's daughter, also a nurse, and a coworker made a pact that their daughters would become Girl Scouts—and their mothers would be the leaders. Of course, Helen agreed. "I knew I'd be a leader," she said, "because Girl Scouts was such a strong part of my life. I wanted that for my granddaughter too." That one small troop grew and welcomed girls from across multiple counties that at one point had 74 girls.

Helen served for nearly a decade as a Service Unit Manager, and also as Service Unit Cookie Manager for Madison and South Gibson counties, and as a recruiter, appearing on the local PBS station and speaking at civic organizations and the local United Way about the deeper purpose of Girl Scouting. "It's not just about cookies," she emphasizes. "It's about courage, confidence, and character."

One of her proudest achievements was turning a small troop Earth Day project into a council-wide environmental celebration in partnership with TDOT. "It all started with one idea for my troop," she shared, "and it became something bigger than I could imagine."

Helen has taken many trips across the country with her Girl Scouts—Savannah (five times!), Washington D.C., Chicago, Branson, Asheville, Gulf Shores, and most recently, Destin—twice in one week with two different age groups! Her troop has toured air traffic control centers, met judges, deputy marshals, architects, and pharmacists.

Over the years, Helen has received numerous honors: the Outstanding Leader Award, Appreciation Pin, Thanks Badge I and II, and the Florence Nightingale Award for her 30-year career in neonatal nursing. She's also been to Pax Lodge and proudly wears her WAGGGS pin.

Helen's most lasting impact lies in the ripple effects she's had on generations. After her Girl Scouts visited her hospital's neonatal unit. Two moms were so inspired that one decided to stay in nursing, and another left her bank job to pursue a nursing career, and both joined the neonatal unit. Their daughters? One is now a pharmacist and the other a nurse anesthetist. "Girl Scouting," Helen says, "put me at the right place, right time, with the right people."

Now preparing to retire next spring after 30 years of troop leadership, Helen reflects on the girls—and the mothers—who convinced her to stay. "It's not just the awards or the trips—it's that they remember the friendships, the courage to speak, the joy of discovering something new, and the power of the Girl Scout sisterhood that reaches around the world."




