Scholarships for Graduating Seniors

GSHS Council Scholarships are available for Ambassador Girl Scouts who are graduating in 2026! Applications are due March 15 for the following opportunities:

Dianne Belk Gold Award Scholarship

This scholarship is open to any girl who has earned the Girl Scout Gold Award by March 1 of her 12th grade year. It is awarded based on achievement in Girl Scouting, academics, leadership, and extracurricular activities. The Dianne Belk Gold Award Scholarship is a one-time scholarship of \$1,000. One scholarship is available each year. The [application](#) is due March 15.

Girl Scouts Heart of the South Gold Award Scholarship

This scholarship is open to any girl who has earned the Girl Scout Gold Award. It is awarded based on achievement in Girl Scouting, academics, leadership, and extracurricular activities. The Girl Scouts Heart of the South Gold Award Scholarship is a one-time scholarship of \$1,000. One scholarship is available each year. The [application](#) is due March 15.

Debbie Moore Memorial Scholarship

This scholarship is open to any graduating senior Girl Scout who has earned the Girl Scout Gold Award and has shown exceptional kindness, and caring for others. It is awarded based on achievement in Girl Scouting, academics, compassion, leadership and extracurricular activities. The Debbie Moore Memorial Scholarship is a one-time scholarship of \$500. One scholarship is available each year. The [application](#) is due March 15.

West Tennessee Girl Scout Scholarship

All graduating Girl Scout Ambassadors living in Benton, Carroll, Chester, Crockett, Decatur, Dyer, Gibson, Halls, Hardeman, Hardin, Haywood, Henderson, Henry, Lake, Lauderdale, Madison, McNairy, Obion, or Weakley county are eligible to apply. This scholarship is awarded based on achievement in Girl Scouting, academics, leadership, and extracurricular activities. The West Tennessee Girl Scout Scholarship is an \$8,000 scholarship (\$1,000 per semester for up to 8 semesters). Five scholarships are available. The [application](#) is due March 15.

Girl Scout Bronze & Silver Award Recognitions - 2026!

Troops who are working towards their Girl Scout Bronze and Silver Awards and want to be recognized during the 2026 council-wide recognition ceremony have until March 31st to submit their information and Final Reports to the council. Troops who submit their recognitions between April 1, 2025 and March 31, 2026 will be recognized in this year's ceremony and all council 2026 recognitions. This deadline has no effect on local Troop or Service Unit spring recognition deadlines and is put in place in order to prepare materials and presentations for the council-wide recognitions.



Troops that haven't completed their projects by March 31st will be recognized during the council recognitions the following year. Absolute Final deadline to earn the Bronze Award is September 30th (fall) of a girl's 6th grade year and deadline to earn the Silver Award is September 30th (fall) of their 9th grade year.

February 2026 Volunteer Spotlight

Deona Davis

Deona Davis knows firsthand the lasting impact Girl Scouts can have. Growing up in Grenada, Mississippi, Deona spent seven years as a Girl Scout herself, enjoying field trips, first aid activities, the Girl Scout Cookie program, and time exploring nature trails with her multi-level troop. Those early experiences planted a seed that would later grow into a deep commitment to the program as an adult.

Deona reconnected with Girl Scouts when she attended a recruitment event in Southaven with her daughter, Reagan. After sharing her own Girl Scout memories, Deona watched Reagan's curiosity spark—and she signed her up right away. What started as support for her Daisy quickly turned into active volunteer involvement. Deona has since served with Troops 10258 and 13222 and was recognized last year as a Distinguished Leader at the troop level, a testament to her dedication and heart for the girls.

One of Deona's greatest joys has been watching Reagan grow from a shy kindergartener into a confident Junior Girl Scout who leads songs, recites the Girl Scout Promise, earns badges, and works toward her Bronze Award. Deona believes Girl Scouts is vital for building communication skills, confidence, and lifelong friendships, calling the troop experience a place where girls become "sisters."

As a volunteer, Deona helps with badges, supports meetings, assists other girls, and jumps in wherever she's needed. Her advice to new leaders is to seek training, lean on experienced volunteers, and build strong connections—because, as she says, "we may not know everything, but we can always lean on each other."





(Attire must include a vest, sash, or tunic with required insignia.)



- Girls must be pictured at the set-up cookie booth wearing their Girl Scout uniform (tunic, vest, or sash, with required insignia).
- The name of each girl pictured must be listed on the [FORM](#) where indicated.
- Upon completion of the [FORM](#), patches will be available for pickup at your choice of GSHS Trefoil Trunk shop location (indicate on the form). Patches will not be mailed.

Girls are only eligible to receive 1 patch.

Girls must be currently registered members of GSUSA to qualify.

- Your troop could be surprised with a Pop-Up Party at any booth location throughout the council. NOTICE REGARDING PREVIOUSLY-SENT DIGITAL COOKIE EMAILS:


Recently, Salesforce Marketing Cloud (the email service utilized by GSUSA) made a decision impacting every Marketing Cloud instance worldwide to forcibly expire every link generated before January 21. This was done to patch critical vulnerabilities as a precautionary security measure for all customers. GSUSA has finished conducting a technology security assessment, and our data remains secure.

In order to help support councils and girls, the Digital Cookie team resent invitation emails to all recipients who had previously been invited to register to create their Digital Cookie site but had not yet completed registration. These new links are now active and functioning as intended and will help the girls register and create their Digital Cookie sites.

Given there was a resend of emails, a small number of users may still encounter a message stating that their link is no longer valid. If so, selecting the “resend email” option will immediately generate a new, safe, active link allowing for immediate registration.

On January 29, GSUSA also resent marketing emails originally sent by Girl Scouts through Digital Cookie between January 1-21, 2026. This resend included the same content as the original email sent through Digital Cookie. Although a user may receive duplicate emails, these new emails will have valid links to purchase. To avoid over-messaging, each customer received only one resend.
