Activity Accident Insurance Going Fully Automatic, Effective October 1, 2025

Girl Scouts provides Activity Accident Insurance underwritten by Mutual of Omaha to support Girl Scouts participating in Girl Scout approved and supervised activities and events.

Activity Accident insurance is automatic upon membership registration and applies to all adult and youth members who may become injured during a Girl Scout approved and supervised activity.

This coverage works like supplemental medical/health coverage and is intended to help with out-of-pocket medical expenses that may not be covered by personal insurance.

Activity Accident insurance extends to non-members who are invited to participate in a Girl Scout approved and supervised activity, whether an adult volunteer for the day, or a friend of a Girl Scout who is joining along to try out Girl Scouting.

Activity Accident coverage applies to day events, overnight trips (including camp), and international travel. A summary of these coverage types for each category can be found **HERE**.

Effective October 1, 2025, Activity Accident Insurance will be completely automatic. In addition to accident/injury coverage for day events, the new policy will automatically include sickness coverage for all overnight stays (including camp) and international travel. This change, effective for trips occurring on and after October 1, 2025, eliminates the need for manual individual insurance requests entirely.

On-Time Membership Renewal

Troop Leaders should review their roster in the Volunteer Toolkit (VTK) to get an up-to-date list of all members who are renewed for 2025-2026. We encourage leaders to use the VTK roster as opposed to the one found under the "Troop" tab in MyGS. The VTK is meant to show a current list of members, whereas MyGS is used to manage memberships and contact information for members of your troop. MyGS will continue to show non-renewed and inactive girls for another full year after their membership with the troop has lapsed. The cleanest, most current roster will always be found in the VTK.

The membership year runs from October 1 - September 30, annually. Any girl or adult who has not renewed their membership by the end of September will no longer be an active member, should not participate in any Girl Scout activities - including the Fall Product and Cookie Programs.

October 2025 Volunteer Spotlight Brenda Storey SU 235 Benton/Tippah

For Brenda Storey of Ripley, Mississippi, Girl Scouting is a dream fulfilled—not for herself, but for the generations that followed. Growing up in the late 1950s and 1960s, Brenda never had the opportunity to join a troop. While she admired Girl Scouts from afar, there were no troops accessible to her. "I really wanted to be a Girl Scout," she recalls, "but there was just no opportunity for me." That absence only strengthened her resolve to ensure her own daughter could experience what she had longed for

When her daughter Evie was in the fourth grade, a Girl Scout information form from school connected them to Girl Scouts. Evie joined under the leadership of Mrs. Mary Boyd, who guided her troop and Brenda quickly became a troop mom, pitching in whenever help was needed—whether it was a camping trip at Camp Tik-A-Witha or a visit to Shiloh battlefield. "I wasn't officially a leader then," Brenda explains, "but I was always there to help." She proudly watched Evie grow in courage and confidence, eventually earning her Girl Scout Gold Award in 1998.

Today, history is repeating itself—but this time, Brenda is part of it in an even deeper way. Her granddaughter London, who lives with her, joined Girl Scouts in the fourth grade after a recruitment event at Blue Mountain College. From the beginning, Brenda stepped up as an official volunteer and now serves as troop treasurer, chaperone, and all-around supporter. "Things have changed a lot since Evie's time," she laughs, citing digital cookie sales and booth sales as brand-new experiences. "Once I got into the groove of things, I really enjoy it."

The troop Brenda now helps lead is full of energy, spanning Daisy through Cadette levels. Together, they have earned badges in music, cooking, fitness, first aid, and citizenship, while also diving into service projects like donating food, honoring first responders, and giving 20 cases of Girl Scout Cookies to the FedEx House at St. Jude. They've gone on outings to the zoo, skating rink, and Pinson Mounds, and hope to soon be able to travel to Savannah to visit the birthplace of Juliette Gordon Low.

For Brenda, what makes this season of volunteering so special is seeing Girl Scouting through a second generation. She's witnessed firsthand how the program helps girls like London develop confidence, courage, and character. "It's amazing to see them grow, to see their self-esteem build," she says. What matters most to Brenda is that girls truly live the Girl Scout Promise and Law. "It's more than memorizing words—it's about actually doing your best to live them out every day."

- 3. Have a parent/guardian submit online by filling out THIS FORM (uploading the picture is required) by Thursday, October 23rd at 11:45 p.m.
- 4. Just for fun NOT REQUIRED: Post your adorable picture on the designated post thread on our GSHS Facebook page. This thread will open at 7:00 AM on October 21st.
- 5. Pick up your uniform award fun patch at your local Trefoil Trunk council shop later this fall. Stay tuned for more information regarding pickup dates.

Each Girl Scout must submit a separate entry in order to receive a patch. *Girls must be in uniform (vest, sash or tunic) or other Girl Scout "gear," and pictures must be taken at school or in the bus line.**
