# Dec/Jan '25-'26 Volunteer Spotlight Kathy Marsh SU 181 Stateline

For lifelong Girl Scout volunteer and master trainer Kathy Marsh, the journey began at age six on Hahn Air Force Base in Germany. "All the girls were Girl Scouts—it's just what you did," she recalls. After returning to the United States, Kathy continued in troops led by community volunteers, later working four summers at Camp Hardee and Camp Pretty Pond in North Carolina. In college, she remained active in a Campus Girl Scout group.

When she eventually settled in Mississippi, Kathy didn't hesitate—she started a Brownie troop before she even had children of her own. Over the years, she led her daughter's troop from Daisies through high school, guiding them on unforgettable adventures: aquarium overnights in Atlanta, beach trips to Myrtle Beach, multi-state "road trip"

explorations, and even spring-break skiing in North Carolina.

Today, Kathy's volunteerism continues through her service as a trainer, mentor, and service unit manager. She teaches Red Cross Babysitting, First Aid/CPR, Wilderness First Aid, lashing and knots, and orienteering—skills she believes help build courage, confidence, and character in both girls and leaders. She offers her trainings to any troops or Service Units that reach out but advises reaching out well in advance because she keeps a full calendar.

Her decades of dedication have earned her the Volunteer of Excellence, Honor Pin, Appreciation Pin, One Heart Award, and the Thanks Badge and Thanks Badge II and Kathy's motivation remains simple: "Trying new things matters. I want girls—and leaders—to know they can be brave, step outside their comfort zones, and discover what they're capable of."

#### **Product Program Forms**
