July 2026 Volunteer Spotlight Vanessa Walker

Vanessa Walker may not have been able to experience Girl Scouts as a child, but she is making sure other girls have every opportunity to grow through the program. Now in her fifth year as leader of a multi-level troop in Columbus, MS, Vanessa serves not only as a troop leader but also as the Community Relations Coordinator and Cookie Coordinator for the service unit. Through her work with the Columbus Housing Authority, she found her way to Girl Scouts and has been dedicated to helping girls discover leadership, confidence, and community ever since.

What makes Vanessa's troop especially remarkable is the leadership team behind it. She proudly describes them as "a bunch of grandmothers" who have come together simply because they believe in investing in the next generation. While a few volunteers have granddaughters in the troop, many do not—including Vanessa, who has four grandsons. Rather than seeing that as a limitation, she says she is happy to "sow into some of these other little girls." Alongside longtime volunteers Hattie Miller, Jeanette Norman, Debbie Neal, Jackie Weir, and others, the women provide a loving, stable support system that extends far beyond troop meetings.

The troop stays active year-round through museum visits, service projects, leadership experiences, STEM activities, entrepreneurship workshops, travel, and community partnerships. The girls volunteer with United Way, assist at bingo nights for senior adults, earn badges through hands-on learning, and even help lead younger children during Vanessa's summer enrichment camp. Every activity is designed to help girls become confident leaders while giving back to their community.

For Vanessa, Girl Scouts has become a true sisterhood—for both the girls and the volunteers. Her troop is proof that when generations come together with a shared purpose, they create lasting friendships, build confident young women, and leave a legacy that reaches far beyond the badges.

Service Team Budgets

Budgeting is an important part of the service unit planning and finance management process. Service units are required to submit a budget at the beginning of each program year. As a reminder, service unit proceeds cannot be distributed until service units have both a current budget and a complete finance report on file with the council.

Please submit your budget by August 31, 2026. The budget should be developed by the service unit's leadership team to support the program plans for the upcoming year, and submitted [HERE](#) by either the Service Unit Operations Manager or Service Unit Finance Coordinator. Once submitted, the volunteer submitting the form will receive an email confirmation of their submission. Troop & SU Finance Reports

Every year, troops and service units are asked to submit a finance report to the council. *This is a requirement.*

Finance reports are necessary to ensure the proper management of Girl Scout funds. They protect both the hard-earned funds and the volunteers who manage those accounts. Participation in the Fall Product and Girl Scout Cookie Programs, as well as approval for any additional money-earning activities, may be affected for troops who have not submitted this report. These reports are due between June 1 and July 31, 2026.

Troop Finance Reports

The Troop Finance Report can be found in the Volunteer Toolkit (VTK). Troop leaders should work with their troop treasurer to complete the report. This year, both troop leaders and troop treasurers have the ability to access and submit the form. Please be sure you work together to determine who will submit the report and ensure the accuracy of the information submitted.

Here's what you need to know:

1. The reporting period is June 1, 2025 through May 31, 2026. Unless a troop has completed all activities for this current year or is disbanding, reports should not be submitted before June 1 to ensure all income and expenses for the reporting period are included.
2. The bank statements that will be required this year are: September 2025, November 2025, February 2026, and April 2026. A troop's finance report is not complete without all four of these bank statements.
3. Troops are only allowed one submission through the VTK per membership year, so do not submit before you are ready. Once the form has been submitted, it cannot be altered.
4. You will have the opportunity to add attachments to your finance report after you have hit the button to submit your report.
5. After the report has been submitted, troops should download a copy of their finance report to keep for their records and to forward it to the service unit's finance coordinator.

Service Unit Finance Reports

Each service unit is required to submit a [finance report](#) no later than July 31, 2026. The report should cover all income and expenses from June 1, 2025 through May 31, 2026. To ensure the full reporting period is included, the form will not accept submissions prior to June 1, 2026. Service units should be prepared to upload bank statements for the following months when submitting their finance report: September 2025, November 2025, February 2026, and April 2026. Service Unit Operations Managers should complete and submit the report.

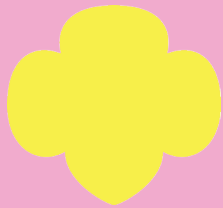

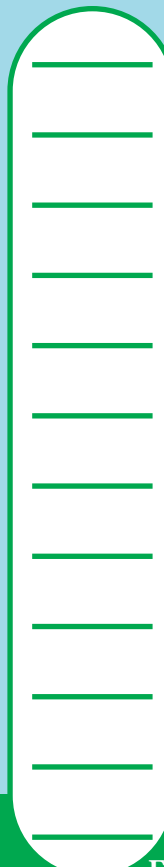

- Kangaroos use their strong tails for balance while jumping. They are the tallest of all marsupials, standing over 6 feet tall.
- Kangaroos live in Eastern Australia in small groups called troops or herds ("mobs" by Australians), typically made up of 50 or more animals.
- Female kangaroos sport a pouch on their belly, made by a fold in the skin, to cradle baby kangaroos called joeys.
- Newborn joeys are just one inch long (2.5 centimeters) at birth, or about the size of a grape.

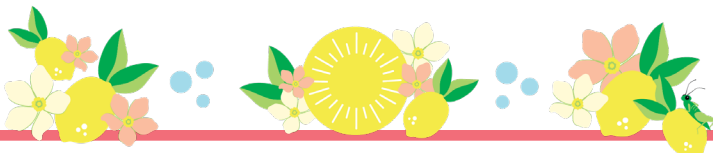
