SATURDAY, SEPT. 6 - Girls begin taking orders in person and online.

THURSDAY, OCT. 9 - Girls submit orders to Troop Fall Product Manager or online.

- Girls can continue taking online orders.

SUNDAY, OCT. 12 - Last day for online Girl Delivered orders.

- Your troop will notify you when to pick up your products.
- Upon pickup, girls immediately begin delivering product and collecting money.

MONDAY, NOV. 3 - Additional product available for pickup at the council.

Passport Bucks may not be cashed for "real money," are non-transferable, have no value outside of Girl Scouts Heart of the South, and expire on 9/4/2026.

I authorize the use of the phone numbers and other contact information, including my mobile number and any future number assigned to me, for calls, texts, emails, to include automated dialers, to contact me regarding my account. PRODUCT PROGRAM POLICIES & STANDARDS

Family Guide

All policies are uniformly enforced and applicable to all troops/adults/girls and MUST be followed.

- All volunteers and girls must be registered for the current membership year to participate in any council product program.
- All Girl Scout eligible grade levels are encouraged to participate in council sponsored product programs.
- Training is required for all Service Unit Product Program Coordinators, Troop Product Program Managers and/or Troop Leaders. Training is also mandatory for at least one caregiver of each girl selling and for the Girl Scout herself.
- Troop Product Program Managers and/or Leaders are responsible for ensuring payment of products ordered and/or received by members of their troop (unsold product included). **NO PRODUCT MAY BE RETURNED TO THE COUNCIL.**
- A signed Caregiver Permission Form must be on file with the troop for any girl participating in product programs. This form outlines the caregiver's financial responsibility to the council. Troops must collect this form before distributing order cards and sale materials.
- Any girl, caregiver or volunteer who has an outstanding balance from a prior program will not be allowed to participate in any future product program until the balance including any processing/collection fees are paid. The caregiver and volunteers involved will be notified of their ineligible status prior to the start of a program, and it will be strictly enforced. If a person questions their placement on the list, they must take the matter up with council personnel.
- Any girl, caregiver or volunteer who has habitually mishandled money/product or has a history (more than one incident) of non-recovered returned checks to the council for any transaction will not be allowed to participate in product programs. The volunteer will be notified of ineligible status prior to the start of the program. These persons may be returned to eligibility only by recommendation of the Service Unit Manager and approval by the Chief Executive Officer.
- Any girl, caregiver or volunteer who is habitually (more than one incident) late (more than thirty days) with product program payments, will be required to either provide payment up front for product or will only be allowed to participate in programs which do not require handling of money (example: online sales only).
- Any person withholding money for any reason from Girl Scouts Heart of the South, in connection with the product program, is subject to litigation/legal action for recovery of all money due and payable, as well as all costs incurred in the collection process.
- In order to receive product program material and/or products, council must have a social security number or the last four digits of the social security number and full date of birth for the person signing the Caregiver Permission Form and/or Product Program Manager Agreement and Policies Form. Troops and/or Caregivers will be asked to pay up front for products if this information is not provided.
- Any report of a girl, caregiver and/or volunteer selling expired product or product other than the official selling price set by Girl Scouts Heart of the South could result in the girl losing all rewards, loss of troop proceeds, their ability to sell in future programs and/or dismissal of volunteer role. Each report will be dealt with individually. The person observing an incident should send a detailed report (who, when, where, selling price, etc.) to the council in writing with information and means to verify details.
- Any report of a girl taking orders prior to the council designated start date could result in the girl losing all rewards. Each report of girls selling early will be dealt with individually. The person observing an incident of early order taking should send a detailed report (who, when, where, etc.) to the council in writing with information and means to verify details.
- Troops and girls may only sell products provided by licensed vendors currently under contract with Girl Scouts Heart of the South during the Fall Product and Cookie Programs.
- A booth sale is a troop activity and requires a caregiver permission slip, attendance by a minimum of one girl and a registered adult as designated by the Troop Leader and cannot take place prior to council booth start dates. Girls make all sales, except in cases where volunteers help younger girls handle money.
- In-person sales (including door-to-door sales and booth sales) must be conducted within the 59 counties represented by Girl Scouts Heart of the South. Only sales to friends and family outside of the Girl Scouts Heart of the South jurisdiction are allowed.
- Online sales (where payment is accepted online) are only permitted through GSUSA approved sites (M2 Online Program, Digital Cookie). Online sales through sites such as eBay, Craig's List, Facebook Marketplace, etc. are prohibited.
- Troop and girl online sales links may be shared via social media with friends and family. Girl contact information, online sales links, or sales information may not be shared or marketed on resale sites, such as FB Marketplace, nor with any news outlets.
- Should any online marketing activities be identified as in violation of guidance, GSUSA or Girl Scouts Heart of the South reserves the right to intervene and request removal or remove the post.

AN EASY SYSTEM FOR ALL FALL PRODUCTS!

M2 ONLINE SYSTEM

With the [M2 Online System](#), girls can create and customize their pages, set goals, track their progress, submit in-person nut/candy orders and select reward options, all while learning the five core skills: goal setting, decision making, money management, people skills, and business ethics.

The M2 Online System is a safe, fun and interactive website where girls can send emails to customers, earn patches, easily grow their sales and learn about goal setting through career exploration!

Throughout the M2 Online System, girls, parents and volunteers will have an easy time participating in the Fall Product Program. No items to deliver and no money to collect! Customers can easily shop for their favorite magazine and treats, place and pay for their orders all online!

Girls can send out emails to customers inviting them to shop, order and pay for their items online. Shipping and handling charges may apply.

SAFETY FIRST!

The internet is an exciting place and opens up a whole new world to us. As girls explore online we want them to be safe and informed. GSUSA created the Internet Safety Pledge to be reflective of the principles outlined in The National Center for Missing and Exploited Children's Online Safety Pledge.

GIRL DELIVERED ONLINE NUT & CANDY ORDERS

- Customers can place orders online for nuts and candy items to be delivered in person.
- Payment for "Girl Delivered" orders is collected online. **DO NOT add these orders to the girl's in-person order card totals.**
- "Girl Delivered" online orders are automatically tallied by the system and will arrive with the Service Unit/Troop delivery between October 30th - November 1st.
- The "Girl Delivered" option is only available to customers through October 12th.
- This option is ideal for family and friends who you plan to see and want to personally deliver items.

DIGITAL DAY NOVEMBER 8TH

Send 20 emails through the M2 Online System to be entered to win a 20 oz. tumbler. Of those qualifying, ten (10) girls will be drawn to win.

Sell \$20 in online sales and be entered to win \$50 in Passport Bucks. Of those qualifying, one (1) girl will be drawn to win.



All girls, as well as their caregiver, must read, agree to and sign the Girl Scout Internet Safety Pledge before girls go online and participate in Girl Scout related activities.

TROOP-TO-TROOPS

Girl Scouts Heart of the South has partnered with Soldiers' Angels to ship nut items to military troops.

Customers can simply select Troop-to-Troops Military "Thank You" Orders on the order card, and order the quantity they want, all at \$6 each. It's a great way to grow nut sales and support our military troops!



Girls that sell 5 Troop-to-Troops Military "Thank You" orders qualify for the *Care to Share* Patch.



SET HER UP FOR SUCCESS!

- Attend her troop's Fall Product Program training; sign and return the [Caregiver Permission Form](#) to the troop. This must be submitted before she begins selling.
- Review the Fall Product Program information together so that she understands it and help her to set her sales goal.
- Help her to set up and complete the [M2 Online System](#). Show an interest in her efforts, help her to think of prospective customers, and perhaps practice her "sales pitch" with her.
- Help her to meet her deadlines by taking orders no earlier than September 6th and submitting her Fall Product orders by the dates set by her Troop Fall Product Manager.
- Promptly pick up her nut & candy order and assist her in the delivery of orders to her customers.
- Submit full payment for all nut and candy orders on the dates set by her troop.

SELLING IN-PERSON

People love to support Girl Scouts! If your girl wants to take in-person orders she can use the Nut & Candy Order Card to take orders from customers.

Girls can submit their orders online, or submit the "Nut Order Form" or the [Girl Order Card Summary](#) (found in this booklet) by the deadline set by your Troop Fall Product Manager. Deliveries will be made to Service Units/Troops between October 30th - November 1st. Once girls receive their product, they can immediately begin delivering items and collecting payment.

Additional Product will be available for pickup at at council beginning November 3rd.

All Products are NON-REFUNDABLE. Damaged items can be exchanged at your local Council leadership center.



GIRL SCOUT SAFETY

- Have your Girl Scout wear her vest, pins, or Girl Scout shirt when selling – something that will identify her as a Girl Scout!
- Never let her sell alone – always have an adult with her.
- Do not go out near or after dark.
- Never, for any reason, approach a parked automobile.
- Never enter a home when asking for orders. If invited to go in, politely refuse and explain that it is against the Girl Scout safety rules for you to go into anyone's home.
